

Migrating from EndNote to RefWorks

- **Product:** New RefWorks

You can easily import your EndNote references into your RefWorks account:

1. In EndNote, go to **Edit > Output Styles > Open Style Manager**
2. Check **RefMan (RIS) Export**.
3. In your EndNote library, select the references you would like to export.
4. Go to **File > Export** and save the file, making sure the output styles field is set to **RefMan (RIS) Export**.
5. In RefWorks, click the "add"

icon, then select **Import References**,

6. Drag and drop the saved file or use the link to **"select a file from your computer"** and upload it.

Import from another reference manager

RefWorks Mendeley


If we don't support importing from your reference manager yet, try exporting your references and import the file.

Import from a file

Need to import from a file, no problem. RefWorks supports hundreds of formats including RIS, BibTeX, and PubMed. Drag and drop the file into RefWorks (into the box below), or use the link to "select a file from your computer" and upload it.

7. RefWorks will try to auto-detect the type of file and find the correct import filter for it. You can also manually select the import filter.



8. You'll receive a confirmation and then click **Ok** to view your imported references in your **Recent** collection.
