Researchers: connect your ORCID to your Repository account

You can now connect your ORCID account with your UWTSD <u>Research Repository</u> account. This allows you to include your ORCID iD automatically with future Repository submissions, and to import your research from your ORCID profile to your Repository account for deposit, or export research previously submitted to our Repository to your ORCID profile.

What's an ORCID iD?

<u>ORCID</u> stands for Open Researcher and Contributor ID: a unique, persistent identifier which is free of charge to researchers and can help ensure that all your grants, publications and outputs are correctly attributed to you.

Connecting your ORCID to your Repository account

- 1. Make sure you have registered for an ORCID and have the details to hand.
- 2. Log in to our Research Repository
- 3. Choose Connect to ORCID from the menu bar at the top right.



- 4. Read through the options and select your preferences:
 - a. Choose whether you want new Repository activity to update your ORCID record: this will automatically add new publications submitted to the Repository to your ORCID profile. By default, this is ticked.
 - b. Choose whether you want to retrieve details of research already included in your ORCID profile to deposit in our UWTSD Repository.
- 5. Click Create or Connect your ORCID iD to link the accounts together.



6. You will be prompted to sign in to your ORCID account. Once signed in, you will be asked to authorise access. Click the button to proceed:
